# Financial Report (Tim Drinkwater)

- Balance Sheet
  - O Giving was below budget for July by -\$7,428 and below the July 2023 giving by -\$8,540 for regular contributions. Fair income was higher than budget for the food booth and parking lot. Income was lower for the food booth in 2024 than in 2023, the spreadsheet above does show it being significantly lower, however the donations to the outside organizations were made in August of 2023 (as the fair ended very close to the end of the month). Let me know if you have any questions about this part. Total income for July was below budget by -\$2,536.
