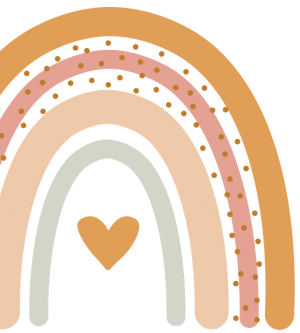

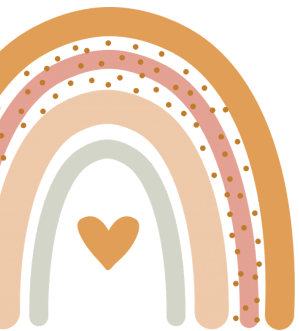
Due to the flooding at First Lutheran, all Sunday School classes will be held at Good Shepherd until further notice.

What We Are Learning

FIRST LOOK (AGES 3–5)

Our preschoolers will discover that **God made them, God loves them, and Jesus wants to be their friend forever.** Through engaging Bible stories, music, games, and hands-on activities, children will learn how much God cares for them.

August: God made me and loves me.

September: God keeps His promises and takes care of us.

October: Jesus shows us God's love and teaches us to love others.

ELEMENTARY (GRADES 1–3)

Children will explore how God's Word helps us live each day as they learn biblical truths through interactive lessons, discussion, games, and activities.

August: Following Jesus and building a strong foundation of faith.

September: Trusting God in every circumstance and showing kindness to others.

October: Living with courage, gratitude, and generosity as followers of Christ.

PRETEEN (GRADES 4–6)

Preteens will dive deeper into Scripture while discussing real-life questions and discovering how faith shapes everyday decisions.

August: Growing as a follower of Jesus.

September: Developing wisdom, integrity, and compassion in daily life.

October: Living out faith with confidence, purpose, and service to others.
